Latest Update: eKYC Deadline Announced

The Women and Child Development Department, Maharashtra, has announced that all beneficiaries must complete their eKYC by November 18, 2025.

Failing to do so may stop the next Rs. 1,500 installment.

Beneficiaries who havent completed eKYC can do it online at ladakibahin.maharashtra.gov.in or visit their nearest CSC (Common Service Centre).

What is Ladki Bahin Yojana?

The Ladki Bahin Yojana, officially known as Mukhyamantri Majhi Ladki Bahin Yojana, was launched by the Maharashtra Government in June 2024.

It provides monthly financial support to women aged 21 to 65 years who belong to low-income families.

# Objective:

To empower women economically, promote financial independence, and help them meet essential needs such as education, healthcare, and household expenses.

#### Key Benefit:

Eligible women receive Rs. 1,500 per month (Rs. 18,000 per year) directly into their bank account.

#### Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Age: Between 21 to 65 years
- 2. Gender: Must be a woman (married, unmarried, divorced, or widowed)
- 3. Residency: Must be a permanent resident of Maharashtra
- 4. Annual Income: Less than Rs. 2.5 lakh per year
- 5. Land Ownership: Should own less than 5 acres of farmland
- 6. Vehicle Ownership: Should not own any four-wheeler (tractor exempted)
- 7. Other Schemes: Should not be receiving benefits from Sanjay Gandhi Niradhar Yojana or similar programs

Offline eKYC (For Non-Linked Mobile Numbers): You can complete eKYC at your nearest CSC, Tehsil Office, or Anganwadi Centre using biometric verification. Installment Update: The Maharashtra Government started crediting the October 2025 installment on November 5, 2025. Only beneficiaries with completed eKYC are receiving Rs. 1,500 directly in their bank accounts. Government Allocation: Rs. 36,000 crore for FY 202526. Key Benefits:

- Not clicking I Agree.
- OTP expiry delay.
- Waiting till the last date.

- Next Installment: November 2025

- Annual Re-verification: June 2026

Ensures funds reach genuine beneficiaries and prevents fraud. From 2026, biometric verification will be introduced for extra security.

- 2. Click Apply Online.
- 3. Fill personal details and upload documents.
- 4. Verify Aadhaar and bank details.
- 5. Submit and note your acknowledgment number.
